The Tuck shop will be operational during school hours to facilitate your purchases but there is no compulsion to buy the books from the school tuck shop .

If your child requires additional help in academics or any session with the school Counsellor please inform the class teacher. We shall arrange it promptly.

For all the students appearing in the Board examination this year, teachers will be available in school for any doubt clearing session and extra classes. Again ,the class teacher should be informed if any student wishes to meet any subject teacher .

Masks and Parental consents are mandatory for all those students seeking entry into the school premises to consult their teachers .

Kindly arrange uninterrupted internet connection for your Child's virtual classes. There may be a few technical snags initially as we begin with online classes but we request you to kindly bear with us as we try to resolve these issues .
