BOOK MARK AND PAPER BAG MAKING



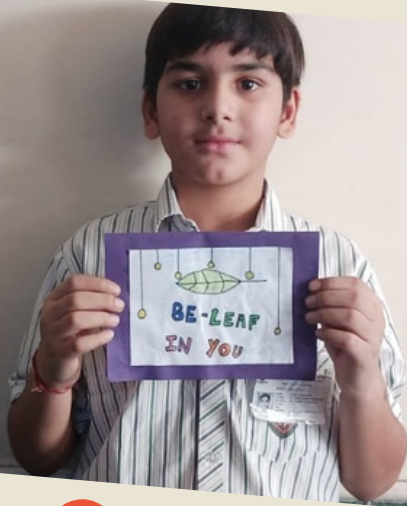

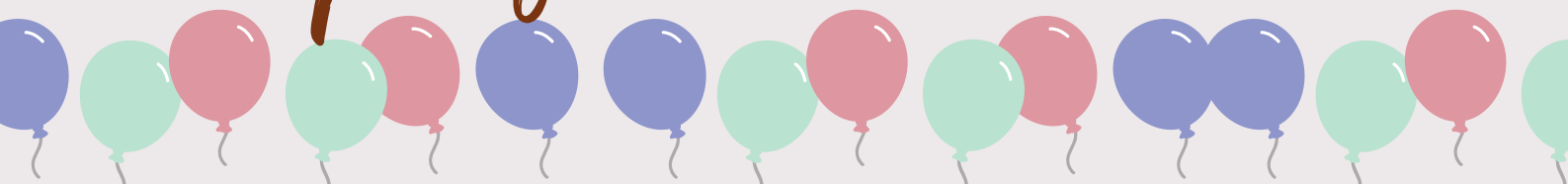
