'Always listen to the colour of your dreams'





On July 21st, the school organized a lively Interhouse Crossword Puzzle activity for students in classes III to V.






'Fun lies in moving beyond comfort zone and discovering the potential of physical endurance'.



At the dawn of the day, When the sun is shining far away. It looks bright and red, When many people are sleeping in their bed. It is a beautiful sight,


