



• Make one musical instrument with the spare things available at home.



Once upon a time Katie, the caterpillar, lost her shoe.




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It hurt her foot to walk without it.



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
So, Katie goes to Spidey. Spidey was a Spider and Katie's friend.

But the frog's shoes were too big for Katie.




