

Mathematics	 Draw a graph depicting the total no. of Olympic medals won by 12 different countries in 2020 Olympics (Graph should depict Gold, Silver and Bronze medals with different colours). Calculate the mean of no. of gold medals won by 10 Asian countries. The Prime Meridian is the line that divides the Earth into eastern and western hemispheres. It is a vertical line of longitude located at 0°.



The points with latitudes north of the Equator are given in °N, while points that are south of the Equator are given in °S.

- 1. Plot the places (cities) in the above world map where last five Olympic games were held.
- 2. Let the coordinates of point A be (40° N, 160° W) and point B be (80° N, 120° W). Find the distance between the points A and B using **Distance Formula**.
- 3. Frame 2 equations (Linear Equations in Two Variables) which pass through the point (10, 40).
- 4. If the speed of an aeroplane is 640 km/hr and the distance between Delhi and Paris is 6568 km, then find the total time taken (in hours).

Suppose another aeroplane left 40 minutes late due to bad weather and in order to reach the destination, 1600 km away, on time, it had to increase its speed by 400 km/hr from its usual speed. Find the usual speed of the plane.
