Scientific Workshop at Dr. B. Lal Institute of Technology

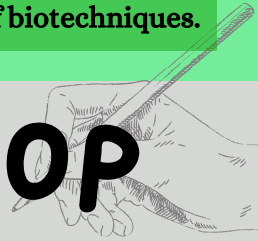


"Biotechnology is the next Information Technology."

The workshop concluded with a tour of Prof. Chetan Singh Solanki's "Energy Swaraj Yatra," a sustainable solar-powered bus, providing a comprehensive understanding of biotechniques.

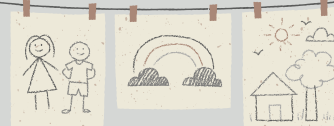


COLOUR BOX WORKSHOP

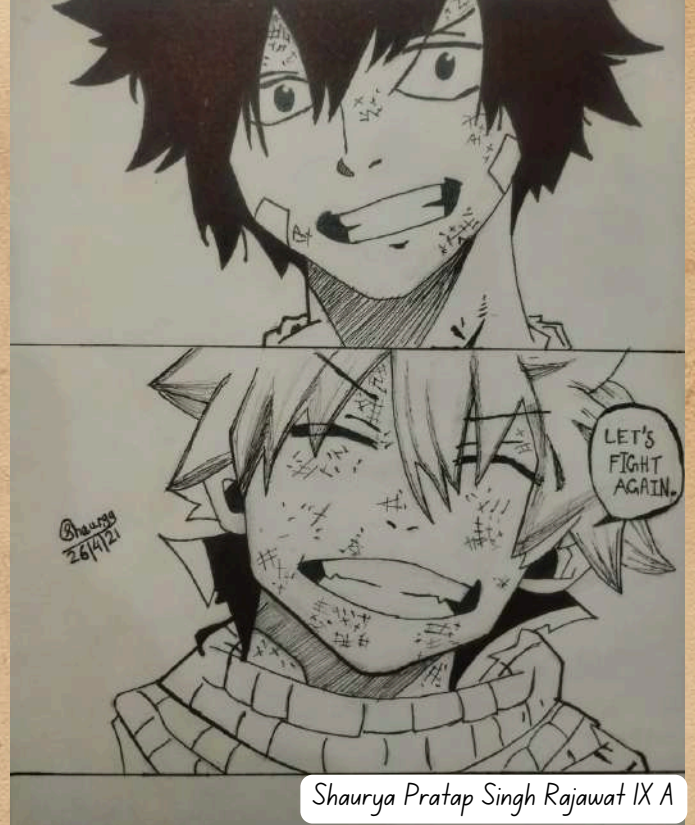


Creativity Corner
