 - ❖ Pick any five words from the newspaper daily and write their meanings from the dictionary.

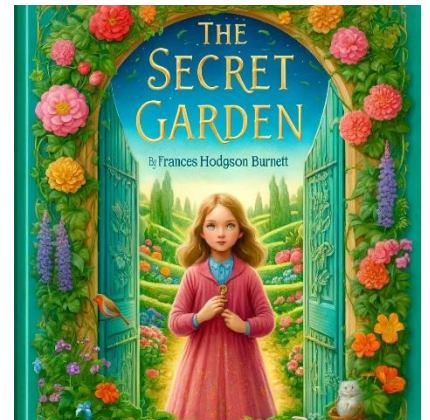
Select your favourite news (any 2) out of the ones you have selected and write why it is your favourite.

Growing a mini indoor biome using a glass jar (terrarium)

Grow your own mini indoor terrarium on the biomes given according to Roll no. mentioned below:

- ❖ Taiga (Boreal forest) Roll no. 1-8
- ❖ Desert Roll no. 9-16
- ❖ Grassland Roll no. 17-24
- ❖ Marine Roll no. 25-31
 - You can use any wide mouth glass jar/ jam jar/ mason jar for the above.
 - Take care to provide the right conditions mentioned below to keep the terrarium lush and rejuvenated as per the characteristics of the Biome allotted to you .
 - Soil rich in nutrients, if not add manure
 - Bright, indirect sunlight
 - Watering at regular intervals.
 - Keep on rotating the terrarium to ensure even light exposure
 - Relate your experiences with that of Mary and record your observations and experiences in 5 sentences.
