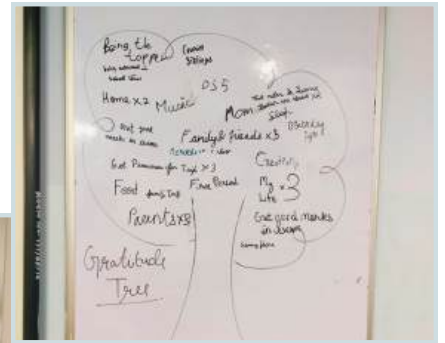

## BEST SCORE WILL COUNT

**Twice-a-year** | Starting 2026, Class X board exams will be held in February & May-June

**Flexible attempts** | Students can choose to appear for either or both exams & select all or specific subjects for each attempt

**Best score counts** | The final certificate will reflect the best score obtained in either of two exams

**Compact exam schedule** | Shorter gaps between exams, with one-day or zero day breaks to streamline the process

**Two difficulty levels** | Subjects like maths, science, and social science will have basic & standard levels from Class IX form 2026-27 academic session

**Graduation transition** | The flexible format starts in 2026-27, with the first Class X batch under this system appearing in 2028

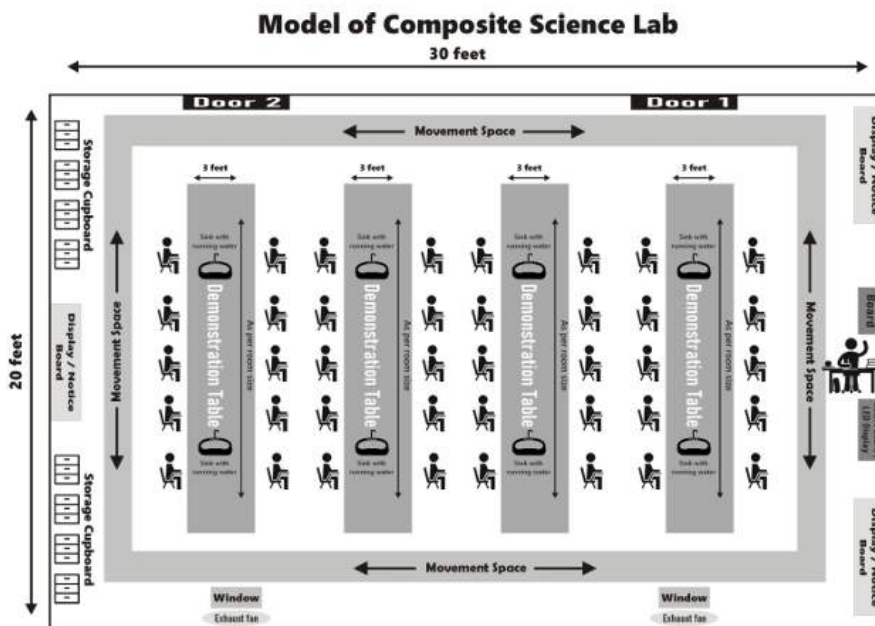




## INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADE

- Composite Science Lab is being developed to foster hands-on learning.



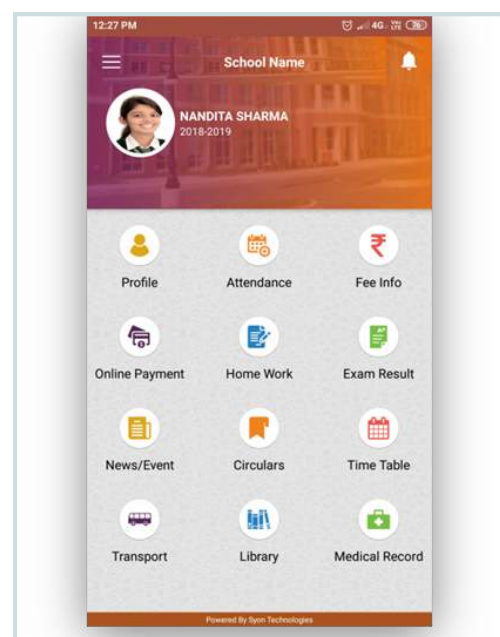
